## Pre-sale of ADAC Rallye Deutschland passes ends soon: last-minute spectators get all the rally action at a discount

- **Pre-sale rally passes and day passes available until 21 August 2019**
- **Rally action starting at €20 available at the on-site ticket outlets**
- **Free admission to the Service Park which also hosts the opening and podium ceremonies**

Munich. Be quick and save up to €15 per pass: the pre-sale for the 2019 ADAC Rallye Deutschland ends on Wednesday (21 August). For a pre-sale rally pass, ADAC members pay €65 (non-members €70) instead of the regular €80 during the event. Day passes (for Thursday, Friday, Saturday or Sunday) for the German WRC event (22 to 25 August) are exclusively available in pre-sale and start at €25. The official online ticket shop is open until 21 August just before midnight. Click [www.adac.de/rallye-deutschland](http://www.adac.de/rallye-deutschland) and go to the Tickets tab to buy a self-print pass which you can redeem on site against a rally pass or day pass.

### For last-minute spectators: on-site passes

Those who did not make the pre-sale, still do not have to miss out on the ADAC Rallye Deutschland. Last-minute spectators can buy their passes at the ADAC local offices in Saarbrücken, Saarlouis, Neunkirchen and St Wendel as well as at the Service Park at Bostalsee. All information on where to buy a pass or redeem a self-print pass can be found at [www.adac.de/rallye-deutschland](http://www.adac.de/rallye-deutschland) (go to the tab Tickets at the event or Ticket exchange points). In addition to the pass, spectators can also buy the official ADAC Rallye Deutschland magazine. It is available at €5 and includes a spectator map. €20 Special Stage passes grant access to the respective Special Stage (SS). The Arena Panzerplatte SS on the Baumholder military range is an exception: the pass costs €25 because rally spectators are offered a much more extensive programme.

### Free admission to the Service Park incl. opening and podium ceremonies

Access to the Service Park on the lakeshores of Bostalsee is free of charge on all four rally days. It is the place to go for the great variety of support events and rally specials. One of these events, hosted at the Service Park for the first time, is the official opening ceremony on Thursday (22 August), starting at 18:00 hours. The central area at Bostalsee is also the venue of the podium ceremony on Sunday (25 August), starting at 14:00 hours.

### ADAC Rallye Deutschland information:

The ADAC Rallye Deutschland has a unique worldwide reputation. Its mix of hairpin stages in the vineyards, tough tracks on the Baumholder tank range and fast asphalt roads presents extreme challenges for both the teams and the drivers.
