





ADAC GT MASTERS FAST FACTS



- » **Rich in tradition:** The ADAC GT Masters is in its 18th season in 2024.
- » **Six stops:** This year's calendar comprises six events in four countries – three in Germany and one in Belgium, the Netherlands and Austria. Each race weekend features two 60-minute races.
- » **Equal opportunity:** All cars are levelled up using the "Balance of Performance", in accordance with the world's leading system, developed by the SRO Motorsports Group, so that every team has a fair chance of winning..
- » **Exclusive tyre partner:** All cars in the ADAC GT Masters start on identical tyres, provided by exclusive partner and Formula 1 supplier Pirelli.
- » **Sustainability:** The topic of sustainability remains a focus of the ADAC GT Masters. This season, the cars will again run on the climate-friendly fuel "Blue Gasoline 98 GT Masters", in which roughly half of the fossil elements are replaced by renewable components. The successful "Bottle-Free Zone" campaign also continues in 2024. Together with BWT, the ADAC is helping to reduce plastic waste in this way for the fourth year in a row.
- » **Tandem:** Two drivers share a car and change places at the wheel of their racer during the pit stop at the half-way point of the race. At least one driver must have the status of a Silver or Bronze driver. New for 2024: Platinum drivers are no longer eligible to start.
- » **Success formula:** Ambitious and talented young drivers battle it out for points and promotion to the DTM in the "Road to DTM".
- » **Festival in the Eifel:** From 12th to 14th June, the ADAC GT Masters will share the bill with the ADAC Truck Grand Prix at the Nürburgring for the second year in a row. The event is steeped in tradition and attracted 130,000 to the circuit in the Eifel Mountains last season, more than any other event last year.
- » **TV partner:** Sport1 is broadcasting all 12 races live and in full in 2024. The ADAC GT Masters will also be shown at sport1.de, on the Sport1 apps, and on the TV partner's social media channels. The races will also be streamed live on the ADAC Motorsport YouTube channel. THREE QUESTIONS FOR ADAC SPORT PRESIDENT, DR. GERD ENNSER

» **This year, the ADAC GT Masters forms part of the "Road to DTM", making it a springboard to the DTM. What does that mean to the series?**

The ADAC GT Masters is an integral part of the ADAC's motorsport programme and has always been a springboard to the DTM. We have now realigned the series for 2024 and given the ADAC GT Masters a new identity with the "Road to DTM". The series has grown in popularity among the teams again, thanks to the realignment, and the driver pairings promise to produce thrilling races at a high standard, with a hard but fair battle to earn promotion to the DTM. Within the framework of the DTM, the races are being held on a high-profile platform, on which the talented youngsters can really showcase their ability.

» **As of 2024, there is a new structure in the ADAC GT Masters. What exactly has changed?**

A new structure gives the series a clear profile. In the future, the focus in the ADAC GT Masters will consistently be on young drivers and ambitious amateur drivers. This has allowed us to make the series more attractive to a wider range of participants. With the Aston Martin

Vantage GT3 and the Ferrari 296 GT3 we welcome another two manufacturers to the series, making the field even more diverse.

» **On two weekends, a new format will be tested in the ADAC GT Masters. What is that format?**

The ADAC GT Masters is the longest-running GT3 series in the world and has been held in the same format for 17 years. It is about time to try something new. With the new endurance format at the Nürburgring, on the support programme for the ADAC Truck Grand Prix, and at the Formula 1 circuit at Spa-Francorchamps, we are introducing an exciting format to the series. The drivers will have a 40-minute sprint on the Saturday and an 80-minute endurance race on the Sunday. Importantly, the costs to the teams will remain unchanged in this new format. The competitors have welcomed the idea of the new format. We are sure that it will also go down well with the spectators.

NEW TO THE ADAC GT MASTERS IN 2024



Changes are afoot in the 2024 ADAC GT Masters. Here is an overview of the most important new features.

» **New promotion concept: "Road to DTM"**

With the "Road to DTM", the ADAC is establishing a new promotion concept for talented young drivers, allowing them to progress from German Kart Championship, the ADAC GT4 Germany to the DTM via the ADAC GT Masters. The best Silver youngster under the

age of 25 competing in the Silver or Pro-Am Cup in the ADAC GT Masters will receive support for the 2025 DTM in the form of the entry fee for the prestigious series.

» **New driver classification**

As of the 2024 season, the ADAC GT Masters will have a revised class structure, which is tailored to the needs of talented youngsters and amateurs. Lining up in the



Silver Cup are pairs of drivers with a Silver classification. One Bronze driver shares the cockpit with a Gold or Silver driver in the new Pro-Am Cup, which is for ambitious amateur and junior drivers. Only pairs of Bronze drivers are eligible for the Am Cup.

» **New super sports cars on the grid**

This season, the new Aston Martin Vantage GT3 and the Ferrari 296 GT3 are making their ADAC GT

Masters debut. With the 2024 version of the Vantage, the British sports car manufacturer returns to the popular GT3 series for the first time since 2021. The Ferrari 296 GT3 is the current flagship of Ferrari and boasts a V6 turbo engine generating roughly 600 hp. The super sports car from Maranello enjoyed international success in its first year.

» **Back in the Ardennes**

The ADAC GT Masters returns to the spectacular 'Ardennes Rollercoaster' at Spa-Francorchamps from 30th August to 1st September. The series last visited the 7,004-kilometre circuit back in 2015.

» **New wet tyres:**

Pirelli will supply a new generation of wet tyres for the ADAC GT Masters and the DTM in 2024. The new tyre will be used exclusively in the two ADAC series this year, before then featuring around the world in GT series supplied by Pirelli from 2025.

» **Exciting sprint and endurance format**

An exciting new format will be used in the ADAC GT Masters at the race weekends at the Nürburgring (12th to 14th July) and Circuit de Spa-Francorchamps (30th August to 1st September). On the Saturday, the drivers will contest a 40-minute race with a driver changeover. The Sunday is then all about the 80-minute endurance race, complete with two mandatory pit stops.

» **Different stationary times**

From this year, as part of the realignment, individual classes will have different stationary times during pit stops. The aim of this is to bring the cars from different classes closer together, thus creating even more exciting racing. While the cars in the Am Cup spend less time stationary in the pit lane, the duos in the higher classes must wait longer in front of their garage.



ADAC GT MASTERS 1X1

» The championship

At the end of the season, the driver with the most points will be crowned "ADAC GT Masters champion". There is also a Team competition. As part of the "Road to DTM", the fastest youngsters with a Silver classification and aged under 25 years who are competing in the Silver or Pro-Am Cup within the ADAC GT Masters are given financial support for the 2025 DTM, in the form of the entry fee. The top 15 in each race score points – 25 for the winner, one point for 15th place. The fastest three in qualifying are rewarded with three points, two points and one point respectively. All drivers are eligible for the Road to DTM classification. Only drivers under the age of 25 and with Silver and Bronze classifications are permitted in the Pirelli Junior competition. The Am-Cup is reserved exclusively for non-professional drivers in the Bronze category.

» The drivers

The field in the ADAC GT Masters consists of aspiring and talented youngsters, and ambitious amateur drivers. Each car is shared by two drivers, and each race features a mandatory driver changeover around the halfway point. All the competitors are classed in three categories according to the "FIA Driver Categorisation System", based on the experience gained and success enjoyed in their career so far. Professionals are given Gold status,

semi-professionals correspond to the FIA category Silver, and non-professionals have the Bronze classification. New for the 2023 season: platinum drivers and all-gold pairings are no longer permitted.

» The cars

Only production-based sports cars that meet the global GT3 standard are eligible to start. The cars weigh between 1,250 and 1,285 kilograms, generate over 550 hp and can be purchased race-ready. The engines are, for the most part, production engines with specific modifications. For this reason, there is a host of different technical concepts. However, only rear-wheel drive is permitted. Equal opportunity is achieved through the "Balance of Performance", which uses additional weight or the manipulation of engine power to regulate the performance of the differently modified cars. This is adapted over the course of the season to suit the different circuit layouts.

» The tyres

This season again sees the teams and drivers use a Pirelli tyre, which offers optimal grip and durability for a longer period of use, whilst also improving the balance of the cars. A maximum four sets of slicks per car can be used each race weekend, with one of those sets reserved exclusively for free practice.

» Free practice sessions and races

The drivers have two free practice sessions, each lasting 45 to 60 minutes, to prepare for the race and test the set-up of their car. The grid positions for each of the weekend's two races are determined in two 20-minute qualifying sessions. The two drivers must each contest one qualifying. The races begin with a rolling "Indy" start.

» Handicap weight/stationary times

Podiums have consequences in the ADAC GT Masters. After each race, the top three are "rewarded" with success ballast. The winner receives an extra 20 kilograms for the coming race. The runners-up must carry an additional ten kilograms, the third-placed car an extra five kilograms. The handicap weights are reset for each race.

» Pit lane

The maximum speed between the two marks in the pit lane (pit entry/pit exit) is 50 km/h throughout the entire race weekend.

» Pit stops

A mandatory pit stop, including a driver changeover, must be taken between the 25th and 35th minute of the race. Refuelling is not allowed. As a rule, the minimum duration of this stop is 70 seconds and is timed between the start and end of the pit lane. To change one or more damaged tyres, or to exchange the tyres on the left and right side of the car, the minimum duration of the mandatory pit stop is extended by ten seconds. Anyone who falls short of this time receives a stop-and-go penalty. A maximum two mechanics may work on the car during a pit stop. In the newly endurance format, the drivers head for the pits between the 15th and 25th minute of the race in both races. A further stop is scheduled in the 80-minute race between the 55th and 65th minute, including a tire change.

» Prize money

The total prize money for this season is € 570,000 in financial and non-cash prizes.

» The points system in the ADAC GT Masters

After each qualifying session, points for the Drivers' Championship are awarded as follows:

1st place: 3 points 2nd place: 2 points 3rd place: 1 point

In the Drivers' Championship, both drivers in a driver pairing receive the points for their respective position in qualifying.

For each race, points are awarded as follows in the Drivers' Championship, Trophy, Team and Junior competitions:

In the Drivers' Championship, both drivers in a driver pairing receive the points for their respective position. Guest starters and cars with single entries do not receive points in any competition. Competitors eligible to receive points are promoted accordingly in the points system.



ADAC MOTORSPORT: INNOVATIVE AND SUSTAINABLE

Sustainability and motorsport are not mutually exclusive: the ADAC is championing sustainable motorsport with various initiatives in both two and four-wheel racing. They include battery electric drive systems in youth development, rallying and at the racetrack, environmentally-friendly fuels and eFuels in automobile sport, and sustainable thinking at big events.

» Environmentally-friendly fuel

The ADAC has taken on a pioneering role with the introduction of an environmentally-friendly fuel, which has also been used for the first time in the DTM and the Prototype Cup Germany since 2023. Developed exclusively by Shell for ADAC racing series, Shell Blue Gasoline 98 GT Masters contains roughly 50% sustainable components and thus contributes significantly to the reduction of CO₂. The fuel meets the standard for Super Plus fuel and can also be used in production vehicles.

The sustainable fuel came through its acid test in 2022 in the ADAC GT Masters, ADAC GT4 Germany, ADAC TCR Germany and ADAC Formula 4. "Blue Gasoline 98 GT Masters" has now been used in 17 different engines from 14 manufacturers.

» Innovative solutions

Arrive at the racetrack like a pro – as part of a team. With the ADAC Pendlernetz powered by twogo, the ADAC is allowing visitors to benefit on two fronts during their trip to the circuit. Not only are they looking after their own wallet, but they are also actively helping to protect the climate.

The ADAC Pendlernetz powered by twogo is an open platform for commuters and lifts, through which private users can register free of charge and network with one another. The app makes it easy to find fellow travellers,

and thus to save fuel and the environment on longer journeys. Simply offer a ride to the racetrack or look to see whether anyone from your region is heading to the same destination. The ADAC Pendlernetz was given the "Presidents Award for Climate Action" by the International Automobile Federation FIA in 2023. The award recognises commitment to innovative solutions and bold actions to help overcome ecological challenges.

» Sustainable series

A fuel without fossil components is also used in the youth development system within the ADAC XC Cup, a series with standard CrossCars (XC). A sophisticated carsharing concept, which sees two starters share each car, also cuts acquisition, transport and running costs, making participation affordable and sustainable. The ADAC and Opel are doing pioneering work on the rally scene. Since 2021, the first battery electric rally series in the world – the ADAC Opel e-Rally Cup – has gone up against the clock with standard Opel Corse e-Rally cars. The 136-hp Opel not only shows a broad audience just how much fun electric cars can be to drive, but also how suited they are to a competitive environment. The cup series, run by the ADAC and Opel, is teeming with innovations: from the cars to the charging infrastructure, which has been developed specifically for the series. Devised in cooperation with Opel Motorsport, the charging infrastructure for the ADAC Opel e-Rally Cup uses the public power grid, whereby renewable green electricity is obtained from the respective grid operator. Motorcycle racing is also electrified: the electric KTM SX-E5 is used for the one-day taster courses in the ADAC MX Academy for children between 6 and 13 years of age. .

» Bottle-Free Zone

In 2021, the ADAC and water technology company BWT launched a successful initiative to make events more sustainable with the "Bottle-Free Zone" in the ADAC GT Masters. True to the slogan "Change the world, sip by sip", free water dispensers in the paddock help to reduce plastic waste and avoid the unnecessary transport of drinking water. Over the past three years, more than 526,000 plastic bottles have been saved in this way.

ADAC GT MASTERS REMAINS ON SPORT1


The ADAC GT Masters can once again be seen on German free-to-air TV in 2024, courtesy of SPORT1. The sport platform will broadcast the races live and in full. As well as the ADAC GT Masters, SPORT1 is also showing the ADAC GT4 Germany races live. Both series will also be covered at SPORT1.de and on the SPORT1 social media channels.

The expert on-air team at SPORT1 has years of experience in sports reporting and a wealth of expertise in active motor racing. The TV broadcast begins with extensive pre-race coverage, with fascinating information on the upcoming race. Fans can also follow the races in a livestream at SPORT1.de and on the YouTube channel @adacmotorsports, with commentary available in German and English.

The ADAC GT Masters not only enjoys an extensive TV presence in Germany, but the series is also the subject of great interest internationally. For example, fans in Austria can look forward to coverage on ServusTV. All ADAC GT Masters races can be seen live and free on the digital platform ServusTV. In total the ADAC GT Masters will be broadcast live or re-live in territories, reaching 225 million TV households.
