Instead of a classic finish line, there will be a so-called Catcher Car, which gradually reels in the participants, virtually or at an organised event. Once a runner has been overtaken by the Catcher Car, they are deemed a finisher. The fee to take part in the run is ≤ 25 , with 100% of that going directly into spinal cord research.

"Wings for Life is dedicated to finding a cure for spinal cord injuries, a very important issue, which the DTM is very happy to support. The Wings for Life World Run brings together athletes from all over the world and gives every DTM fan the opportunity to do their bit and run for a good cause as part of Team DTM. We are pleased to be involved and hope that many DTM fans will join Team DTM and run for those who no longer can on 4th May. We also want to carry this sense of community into the DTM and support cutting-edge research together with our fans," says ADAC Motorsport Director Thomas Voss.
