DTM Norisring: Tickets for the Nuremberg highlight available now

- **Highlight of the 2026 DTM season on first weekend of July**
- **Ticket prices start at € 74, free admission for under 16s**
- **New category with cheaper admission to popular grandstands**

Munich. The DTM returns to the legendary Norisring - the absolute highlight of the DTM calendar and a crowd-puller every year - from 3rd to 5th July. Tickets are available now online at dtm.com. Ticket prices start at € 74, while under 16s enjoy free admission, including to the stone grandstand, when accompanied by an adult. New this year: an additional ticket category allows particularly cheap access to specific seats. ADAC members also benefit from a 10% discount at all DTM events.

The Norisring is one of a kind: the narrow track flanked by guardrails and walls, the idyllic views of the Dutzendteich lake, and the iconic stone grandstand have earned Germany's only street circuit cult status. Spectators can secure admission to the stone grandstand, which offers the best view of the start/finish straight and the pit lane, for as little as € 74. Thanks to the new ticket category, there are now cheaper reserved seats in the Thomas Sommer Stand, the Speck-Pumpen Stand, and the Pit Lane Stand.

All tickets include free admission to the paddock, autograph sessions and Pit Walk, as well as free use of public transport on the VGN network around Nuremberg, making it easy for visitors to travel to the event in comfort and sustainably on public transport.
