Tatuus to supply ADAC Formula 4 chassis Long-term partnership for ADAC entry-level formula series commencing in 2015

Munich: Tatuus will be supplying chassis for the new ADAC Formula 4 series from the 2015 season onwards. The ADAC decided on the Italian manufacturer after long and intense deliberation.
